#### **Health and COVID Questions**

Please keep your child home if they have a cough, fever, vomiting, or diarrhea. Please see this <u>handout</u> from MPS for guidelines on when to stay home and when your children can return to school. Please call Ms. Slusher, our nurse, at 874-8448 with any questions.

There have been a few questions about when a classroom or the school would switch to virtual learning. If a classroom has five confirmed cases within 14 days, the classroom will switch to the flexible scheduling/virtual learning environment for 10 days. If the school has 3% of the total population with confirmed COVID cases within 14 days, the school will switch to the flexible scheduling/virtual learning environment for 10 days. Mme Harer will send out information if we get close for either of those metrics so families can prepare.

#### **Inclement Weather Dismissal- Parent Pick Up**

We have been listening to your feedback as parents for our inclement weather dismissal. We have changed our procedure. All children will be sent with the youngest sibling so parents will only have one place to pick up their children.

K4 and K5 students (with their siblings) will be picked up at the Tot Lot doors. The gate will be open and families will line up, K4 on the left, and K5 on the right.

1st-5th grade students will be picked up at the main doors. Parents will line up outside the southernmost main door, and they will be allowed to walk through the foyer to gather their children, then leave out the ramp door. Parents must have a mask to enter the building. We do not have spare masks for adults. Parents that do not have masks will have to wait until after all other parents have gathered their children and a staff member is available to take their children to the door.

#### **Halloween**

At MFIS we want to ensure that seasons and holidays don't define and drive the curriculum of the program and we discourage the overuse of holiday curriculum. We are not advocating eliminating holidays, or depriving students of the opportunities to celebrate. We acknowledge the diversity of our student population and the many different ways they celebrate holidays. For Halloween, students will be allowed to wear

costumes on October 29th as part of our Spirit Week, although we will not be having celebrations in the classroom. Please do not bring treats to school.

- Costumes must be nonviolent (no weapons) and not scary.
- Students still need to wear their face masks per COVID protocol. Other types of face coverings, as part of a costume, are not allowed.

## **Early Dismissal and Pick Up Reminders**

We have been having many children here after 4:05 for parent pick-up. The end of the work day for our staff is 4:05. Please ensure that you are here, picking up your child/children by 4:05. Every time we have children picked up late, we have to pay staff members for their additional time. This takes money away from educational opportunities for your children. Beginning next week, we will start charging a late pick up fee for families picking up after 4:05.

There are **no early dismissal pickups after 3:00pm** and the office needs to know before 2:00pm (414-874-8400). Please remember our teachers do instruct until the end of the day and frequent early dismissals disrupt the day for all students and can lead to truancy problems for your child.

If you need to **make changes** to your child's end of day routine, those requests must be made to the office **before 2pm** (414-874-8400). This will allow for enough time to communicate the change to your child's teacher.

### **Seesaw for Communication**

Please make sure that you are signed up for your child's Seesaw account. This is the main venue for parent communication from the school. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you have any questions.
